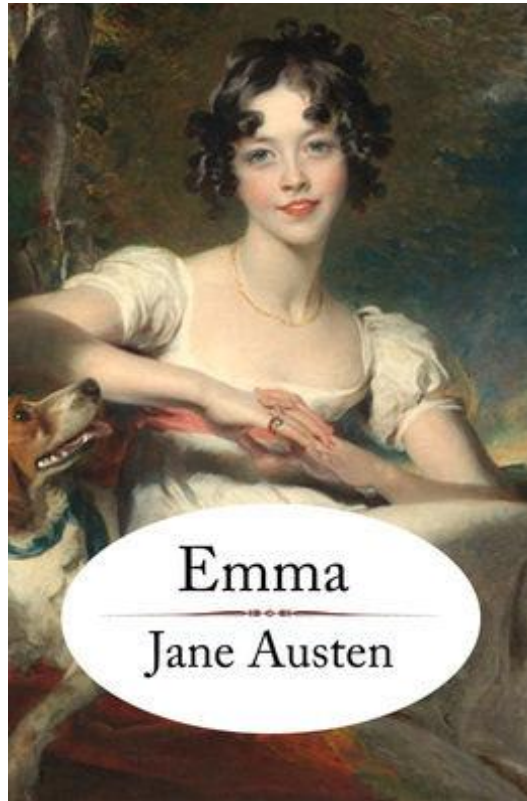


The Emma Ball
